

Biographie Mohamed Jmaiel

Director of the digital research center, Technopark of Sfax

Mohamed JMAIEL obtained his diploma of engineer in Computer Science from Kiel (Germany) University in 1992 and his Ph.D. from the Technical University of Berlin in 1996. He joined the National School of Engineers of Sfax (Tunisia) as Assistant Professor of Computer Science in 1995. He became an Associate Professor in 1997 and full Professor in January 2009. He participated to the initiation of many graduate courses at the University of Sfax. His current research areas include software engineering of distributed systems, formal methods in model-driven architecture, self-adaptive and pervasive systems, autonomic middleware. He conducted many research projects and published more than 220 regular and invited papers in international conferences and journals, and has co-edited six conferences proceedings and five journals special issues on these subjects. He organized and co-chaired the program committees of many international conferences, like MCSEAI'2004, CRiSIS'2009, NOTERE'2010, OPODIS'2010, WETICE'2013, VECOS'2016, and ESBM'2017. He was director of the National Engineering School of Sfax (ENIS), from 2011 to 2014. Currently, he is director of the digital research center at the Technopark of Sfax.
